Bringing Out the Best in Others

I. Introduction

- A. I Corinthians 13:4b (NAS) "Love is kind."
 - 1. Kindness is love in <u>action</u>.
 - 2. We build people up (edify) by kindness, not <u>criticism</u>.

II. How to Bring Out the Best in Others

- A. Give them a personal <u>challenge</u>.
 - 1. Ephesians 4:1 (NAS) I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, entreat you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called.
 - 2. Intuitively, everybody knows that there's more to life than just living for self.
 - 3. All of us need somebody in our lives to <u>inspire</u> us to be what we could be!
- B. Instill confidence in them.
 - 1. When somebody <u>believes</u> in you, it brings out the <u>best</u> in you!
 - 2. Matthew 16:18 (NAS) "And I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades shall not overpower it."
 - 3. I Thessalonians 5:11a (NAS) Therefore, encourage one another and build up one another.
 - 4. "Catch people doing something right and then tell them." (Ken Blanchard)
 - 5. Suggestions on encouraging others:
 - a. It needs to be <u>sincere</u> (genuine).
 - b. It needs to be <u>regular</u>.
 - c. It needs to be specific.
- C. Give them honest <u>feedback</u>.
 - 1. Proverbs 24:26 (NAS) He kisses the lips who gives a right (honest) answer.

- 2. A real friend will tell you when you're about to make a mistake.
 - a. Proverbs 27:6a (NAS) Faithful are the wounds of a friend.
- 3. Correction done the right way builds people up. Correction done the wrong way can <u>scar</u> a person for life!
- 4. The key in bringing correction is your <u>attitude</u>.
 - a. The purpose has to be to correct, not <u>condemn</u>.
 - b. Ask yourself, "What is my <u>motive</u> in this? Am I correcting them for <u>my</u> benefit or for theirs?"
- 5. Ephesians 4:15a (NAS) But speaking the truth in love.
 - a. Affirm the <u>person</u>; correct the <u>behavior</u>.
- D. Praise the growth and changes you see in their lives.
 - 1. Matthew 16:17 (NAS) "Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood did not reveal this to you, but my Father who is in heaven."
- E. Realize there's always a <u>price</u> tag to being a people builder.
 - 1. The biggest cost is <u>unselfishness</u>.

III. How to Start Being a People Builder

- A. Make a decision to start trying.
- B. Pray and ask God who is in your life that He wants you to build up.
- C. Pray and ask God how to do it.
