- A. Because God <u>created</u> everyone.
 - 1. Psalm 8:4-5 (NAS)
 - 2. People are the crown of God's creation!
- B. Because Jesus died for everyone!

 - 2. Proverbs 15:3 (NAS)
 - 3. Proverbs 5:21 (NAS)
 - 4. "A great man shows his greatness by the way he treats little men." (Thomas Carlyle, 1795-1881)
 - 5. Matthew 25:34-40 (NAS)
- C. Because it shows that I know God.
 - 1. I John 4:8 (NAS)
 - 2. Jesus honored the most disrespectful people in society.
 - 3. Matthew 9:10 (NAS)
- D. Because I'll reap what I sow.
 - 1. Galatians 6:7-9 (NAS)

III. How to Honor People

- A. When you speak to people, be tactful, not just truthful.
 - 1. Proverbs 15:1 (NAS)
 - 2. "Remember not only to say the right thing in the right place, but far more difficult still, to leave unsaid the wrong thing at the tempting moment." (Benjamin Franklin)

- 3. Tactfulness is thinking before you speak!
- 4. Definitions of "Tact"
 - a. Tact is not saying everything you think!
 - b. Tact is treating everybody like they know what they're talking about.
 - c. Tact is the art of telling somebody he's <u>open-minded</u> when he just has a hole in his head.

- B. When you are served by people, be <u>understanding</u>, not just demanding.
 - 1. Matthew 7:12a (NAS)
 - 2. Proverbs 16:21b (NAS)
 - a. Politeness changes people, not rudeness.
- C. When you disagree with people, be gentle, not just judgmental.
 - 1. Romans 14:12-13 (NAS)
 - 2. Two things to remember when you disagree with someone:
 - a. Everyone will give an <u>account</u> to <u>God</u> for their lifestyle one day.
 - b. You're not God!
 - 3. We can <u>disagree</u> without being disagreeable!
 - 4. James 3:16-17 (NAS)
 - 5. When you must shoot an arrow of <u>truth</u>, dip it in <u>honey</u>.
- D. When you share your faith with people, <u>respect</u> them, don't reject them.
 - 1. Colossians 4:5-6 (NAS)
 - "Evangelism is just one beggar telling another beggar where to find bread." (Billy Graham)
- E. When people are rude to you, respond politely.
