II. Solomon's Search for Happiness Found Out ...

- A. Wisdom doesn't bring happiness.
 - 1. Ecclesiastes 1:16-18a (NLT) ¹⁶I said to myself, "Look, I am wiser than any of the kings who ruled in Jerusalem before me. I have greater wisdom and knowledge than any of them." ¹⁷So I worked hard to distinguish wisdom from foolishness. But now I realize that even this was like chasing the wind. ^{18a}For the greater my wisdom, the greater my grief.
- B. <u>Pleasure</u> doesn't bring happiness.
 - 1. Ecclesiastes 2:1-2 (NLT) ¹ I said to myself, "Come now, let's give pleasure a try. Let's look for the 'good things' in life." But I found that this, too, was meaningless. ²"It is silly to be laughing all the time," I said. "What good does it do to seek only pleasure?"
- C. <u>Achievement</u> doesn't bring happiness.
 - 1. Ecclesiastes 2:4-5, 20 (NLT) ⁴I also tried to find meaning by building huge homes for myself and by planting beautiful vineyards. ⁵I made gardens and parks, filling them with all kinds of fruit trees. ²⁰So I turned in despair from hard work. It was not the answer to my search for satisfaction in this life.
- D. Wealth doesn't bring happiness.
 - 1. Ecclesiastes 2:7b-8 (NLT) ^{7b}I also owned great herds and flocks, more than any of the kings who lived in Jerusalem before me. ⁸I collected great sums of silver and gold, the treasure of many kings and provinces. I hired wonderful singers, both men and women, and had many beautiful concubines. I had everything a man could desire!
- E. <u>Success</u> doesn't bring happiness.
 - 1. Ecclesiastes 2:9, 11 (NLT) ⁹So I became greater than any of the kings who ruled in Jerusalem before me. And with it all, I remained clear-eyed so that I could evaluate all these things. ¹¹But as I looked at everything I had worked so hard to accomplish, it was all so meaningless. It was like chasing the wind. There was nothing really worthwhile anywhere.
 - 2. Ecclesiastes 2:17 (NLT) So now I hate life because everything done here under the sun is so irrational. Everything is meaningless, like chasing the wind.

III. Jesus' Keys to Happiness

- A. Get to know God
 - 1. Matthew 5:3 (NAS) "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."
 - 2. If anything but <u>God</u> is at the <u>center</u> of your life, you will not be satisfied!
 - 3. "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our heart is restless until it rests in You." (St. Augustine)
- B. Trust God when life is disappointing
 - 1. Matthew 5:4 (NAS) "Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted."
 - 2. If you have to live a <u>problem-free</u> life in order to be happy, you're <u>never</u> going to be happy!
 - 3. Let <u>God</u> handle your <u>hurts!</u>
 - 4. Matthew 28:20b (NAS) "And lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."
- C. Expect God to meet my needs
 - 1. Matthew 5:5 (NAS) "Blessed are the gentle, for they shall inherit the earth."
 - 2. Psalm 24:1 (NAS) The earth is the LORD'S, and all it contains, the world, and those who dwell in it.
- D. Follow God's instructions
 - 1. Matthew 5:6 (NAS) "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied."

- 2. When you follow God's principles, you benefit! When you ignore them, you get hurt!
- E. Cultivate a forgiving heart
 - 1. In life, there will be people who <u>hurt</u> you.
 - 2. Your <u>response</u> to that hurt will determine whether you become <u>bitter</u> or joyful.
 - 3. Matthew 5:7 (NAS) "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy."
- F. Maintain a <u>clear conscience</u>
 - 1. Matthew 5:8 (NAS) "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God."
 - 2. Guilt destroys happiness!
 - 3. You can live quilt free!
 - a. I John 1:9 (NAS) If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- G. Build <u>healthy</u> relationships
 - 1. Matthew 5:9 (NAS) "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God."
 - 2. It doesn't matter if everything else in your life is great. If your relationships are bad, life stinks!
- H. Live with an <u>eternal</u> perspective
 - 1. Matthew 5:10 (NAS) "Blessed are those who have been persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."
 - 2. Doing the right thing is not always easy. But, you'll have <u>eternity</u> to enjoy the <u>rewards</u> for doing the right thing!
